The Impact of Traumatic Childbirth on Mothers' Experiences Caring for Their Children

In order to help clinicians provide better care to mothers who have experienced a traumatic childbirth Dr. Cheryl Beck (Professor at the University of Connecticut) and Sue Watson (Chairperson of TABS) are now conducting a research study on the impact of traumatic childbirth on mothers' experiences caring for and interacting with their children. Women who have experienced a traumatic childbirth are invited to participate in this survey. In order to participate, women need to be 18 years of age or older and be able to read and write English. The study will be conducted over the Internet using Survey Monkey.

If you agree to take part in this survey you will be asked to complete (1) a participant Profile Form which includes questions about yourself such as your age, education, and type of delivery, and (2) to describe in as much detail as you wish the impact your birth trauma has had on your experiences of caring for and interacting with your infant and any other children you may have. Depending on how in depth you write about your experiences, participation in the study could take between 30- 60 minutes. Your participation will be anonymous and you will not be contacted again in the future.
